HOW TO USE: Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and containerized ponds that **do not** contain fish. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and containerized ponds containing heavy growth of algae must be cleaned prior to using this product.

ROUTINE USE: For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 11 to 16 fluid ounces of Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pools, add 6 to 11 fluid ounces of Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools that have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 6 to 10 fluid ounces of Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of the swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 12 to 16 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control throughout the water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times durine the off-season.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and containerized ponds having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control per 1,000 gallons of water.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain or containerized pond, add 0.6 to

1.1 fluid ounces of Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control per 1,000 gallons of water, Subsequent additions

of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control must be made every 5 to 7 days after

Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies Algae Control with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
