# For Models #200200(T) Easy Incline & #200300 Pro Series

### Ladder Components

Component	Qty
A) In-Pool Ladder Body	1
B) Handrails	2
C) Deck Flange	2

### Hardware Kit

Hardware	Qty
D) #10 x 3/4" Tek Screw	4
E) #10 x 1" Panhead Screw	6

**Tools Required:** Phillips and standard screwdriver or bit, drill, 1-1/2" hole saw, pencil.


**Note:** Handrails should be mounted through the deck boards for proper installation.

**Note:** Before you begin the assembly of your ladder/step, please insure you have all components and hardware.

**Note:** Contact our customer service department to request any missing or damaged parts, hardware or labels at 888-333-1134.

### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

- Install ladder per manufacturer's instructions.
- Locate IN-POOL LADDER on solid base.
- Ladder is designed for use by one person at a time.
- This ladder is intended for use as a swimming pool ladder only.
- Face ladder when entering and exiting the pool.
- No jumping, no diving from ladder.
- Do not swim through, behind or around the ladder.



### STEP BY STEP ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1: Insert handrails into ladder body.**



**Step 2: Center and mark desired hole location on deck boards with pencil.**



**Step 3: Use 1 1/2" hole saw to create handrail holes in deck boards.**



**Step 4: Center deck flanges over holes and mount to deck using (6) #10 x 1" screws.**



**Step 5: Insert handrails down through deck flanges until ladder body is resting flat on pool floor.**




**Step 6: Secure handrails to deck flanges using #10 x 3/4" tek screws.**



**Finished!**



**NOTE:** Be sure to fully insert the handrail into the ladder socket and secure with one set screw #10 x 3/4" Tek Screw (D). Screw should be secured through outside of each ladder socket into the handrail to act as a set screw to secure the handrail to the ladder body.
