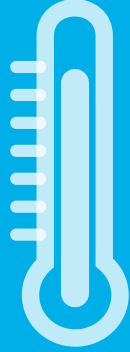




HOT TUB MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

DAILY

- **CIRCULATE AND FILTER WATER**
Water should pass through the filter at least twice daily.
- **CHECK THE CABINET AND COVER**
See if there are any signs of a problem, such as a leak or a skewed cover.
- **TAKE THE TEMPERATURE**
High or low water temperature can indicate a problem.



DAILY

WEEKLY

- **TEST AND BALANCE THE WATER**
Check water chemistry levels at least 2-3 times per week.
- **SHOCK THE WATER**
Use Leslie's Chlor Brite at least once a week, and add a bit of Leslie's Fresh 'N Clear each time you get out of the hot tub.
- **AIR OUT THE COVER**
Prevent mold and mildew by removing the cover and allowing it to dry once or twice a week.
- **CLEAN THE HOT TUB**
Remove dirt and debris with a spa wand or vacuum. Wipe down surfaces and waterline to prevent scum and scale.
- **CLEAN THE FILTER**
Rinse the filter with a spray nozzle or filter cleaner. Use a cartridge cleaning chemical to remove excess oils and residues.

WEEKLY

MONTHLY

- **GET PROFESSIONAL WATER TESTING**
Leslie's offers free 10-point water testing to help keep your hot tub clean and safe.
- **THOROUGHLY INSPECT THE COVER**
Check for cracks, broken stitching, warping, water in the foam layer. Order a replacement if needed.

QUARTERLY

- **CLEAN AND CONDITION THE HOT TUB COVER**
Keep your cover looking like new with cover cleaner and conditioner.
- **PURGE THE PLUMBING**
Eliminate biofilm buildup in hot tub lines with a product like Spa Purge prior to draining.
- **DRAIN AND REFILL THE HOT TUB**
Keep water fresh by draining and refilling the water every 3-4 months. Also a good time to deep clean all surfaces.
- **SOAK THE FILTER**
Soak filter cartridges in a filter cleaning solution to break down organic buildup on the pleats. Rinse thoroughly.

YEARLY

- **REPLACE FILTER CARTRIDGE(S)**
Most filter cartridges have a 12-month lifespan. Fibers grow looser and become harder to clean, signaling time for replacement.
- **OPEN THE SPA CABINET**
Look for signs of pests, electrical damage, and water leaks. Repair as necessary, including lubricating o-rings and gaskets.



YEARLY
