- 1 Clean the filter.

Cartridge Filter

Rinse the filter with a hose.

For best results, clean using **Leslie's Cartridge Cleaner**.

D.E. Filter

Backwash the filter then recharge the filter with **Leslie's Low Dust D.E.**

Sand Filter

Backwash the filter. For best results, use **Leslie's Sand Filter Revitalizer**.

- 2 Turn on the pool's circulation pump if necessary, remove the pool timer trippers to ensure continuous operation of the pump throughout the algae removal process.
- 3 Adjust the pH to 7.8 or higher.
- 4 Adjust the Total Alkalinity to 80-120 ppm depending upon the type of primary sanitizer used. (80-100 ppm for sodium hypochlorite, calcium hypochlorite or lithium hypochlorite and 100-120 ppm for dichlor, trichlor and bromine tablets.)
- 5 Adjust the Cyanuric Acid level to 25-75 ppm.

- 6 Adjust the Free Available Chlorine level to 2.0-2.5 ppm

- 7 Thoroughly brush the pool if the pool surface is plaster, gunite, or concrete, use a wire brush; for all other surfaces, use a brush with nylon bristles. **Warning: Wire brushes are NOT to be used with vinyl liners, painted pools, fiberglass pools, and above-ground pools.**

- 8 Add ____ lbs of **Green To Clean** or **Yellow Out** directly into the pool water. Spread half of the prescribed amount along the perimeter of the pool, starting where the algae is the thickest. Concentrate the remaining half directly over the problem areas. Wait 5 minutes. **See Warning Below.**

- 9 Add _____ lbs of **Power Powder Plus 73** directly to the pool. Wait 12 hours.

- 10 Add _____ lbs of **Power Powder Plus 73** directly to the pool. Wait 12 hours.

- 11 Add _____ lbs of **Power Powder Plus 73** directly to the pool. Wait 12 hours.

- 12 Turn off the pool's circulation pump and clean the filter. Follow the instructions in Step 1.

- 13 Turn on the pool's circulation pump. Once sanitizer level is below 5 ppm, add _____ capfuls of **Leslie's Clear Aid** to remove dead algae (1 capful per 2,000 gal).

- 14 Adjust phosphate Levels. Check regularly to make sure your levels are 100 ppb (parts per billion) or lower.

- 15 To remove the algae food source, add **Leslie's noPHOS** based on test results. To maintain phosphate levels below 100 ppb, add _____ capfuls of **Leslie's Perfect Weekly** (1 capful per 8,000 gal) on a weekly basis.
