AUTOMATIC CHLORINATORS AND FLOATING CHLORINATORS: Add Leslie's Swimming Pool Supplies 3" Jumbo Tabs according to the directions on your chlorinator.

CARTRIDGE CHLORINATORS: Remove top of cartridge and refill with Leslie's Swimming Pool **Supplies 3" Jumbo Tabs.** Follow the directions on the cartridge. Important: Allow the empty cartridge to dry before refilling.

#### DO NOT ADD LESLIE'S SWIMMING POOL SUPPLIES 3" JUMBO TABS DIRECTLY INTO THE POOL OR THE POOL SKIMMER AS DAMAGE WILL OCCUR.
