DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
dOSAGE RATES
EVERY THREE MONTHS: 16 fl. oz. SEAKLEAR 90-DAY ALGAE PREVENTION \& REMOVER per 10,000 gallons pool water (or 500 mL per $40,000 \mathrm{~L}$ ) will prevent algae growth in all pool types.
SEVERE ALGAE TREATMENT: $32 \mathrm{fl} .0 z$. SEAKLEAR $90-$ DAY ALGAE PREVENTION \& REMOVER per 10,000 gallons pool water (or 1 Liter per $40,000 \mathrm{~L}$ ).

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

1. Maintain pool water in the pH range 7.2 to 7.8 . Total alkalinity 80 ppm to 120 ppm . Adjust pH to 7.2 for severe algae.
2. Ensure that filtration system is working properly.
3. Brush pool regularly.
4. Calculate the volume of SEAKLEAR 90-DAY ALGAE PREVENTION \& REMOVER required for your pool.
5. Add the product directly to pool deep end preferably in front of a water return. Dilute in a bucket of pool water when adding to pools with plaster finishes.

SEAKLEAR 90-DAY ALGAE PREVENTION \& REMOVER must be used along with adequate levels of an EPA registered sanitizer (e.g. chlorine) to control bacteria.
