Skim and brush pool

Skim leaves and debris from pool. Brush pool walls and floor to loosen dirt and algae.

Test pool water

Bring a water sample to **Leslie's** for a **FREE AccuBlue 10-point water test** OR complete an at-home water test with a test kit or strips.

Balance pool water

Adjust water balance according to treatment plan or water test results.

Empty pump basket

Empty debris and leaves from pump basket. Replace basket if cracked or damaged.

Empty skimmer basket

Empty debris and leaves from skimmer basket. Replace basket if cracked or damaged. Check skimmer cover and weir gate and replace if cracked or damaged.

Check auto chlorinator (if applicable)

Refill auto chlorinator and adjust settings as needed. Replace cracked, leaking, or broken parts.

Fill the floater (if applicable)

Fill chlorine floater. Replace floater if cracked or damaged.

Monthly

Check your timer

Make sure your timer is set for the season. Ask a Leslie's associate or technician for timer setting recommendations.

Check for leaks

Check for leaks around your pump, filter, valves, and other equipment in the surrounding area. Consult a **Leslie's** associate or technician if leaks are present.

Check pressure gauge

Pressure gauge should be at 0 psi while the pump is off. If not at 0 psi, replace gauge.

Clean filter

Cartridge Filter

- Clean cartridge elements and replace if cracked, torn, or damaged.

D.E. Filter

- Backwash filter
- Clean D.E. grids and replace/recharge with new low-dust D.E powder.

Sand Filter

- Backwash filter
- Replace sand if older than 3-5 years.

Check salt cell (if applicable)

Check salt cell for calcium buildup. If buildup is present, clean cell.

Innual

Lubricate O-rings

Lubricate O-rings on pump lid, filter, and backwash valves (if applicable). Replace if O-rings are stretched, crimped, or cracked.

Check pool cleaner (if applicable)

Check pool cleaner for sufficient suction, cracks, and broken parts. Bring in cleaner for a FREE inspection. If it needs a repair, the labor to fix it is FREE.
