Servicing Procedure


To remove the Bypass Access Plug:


AWARNING

Fire or explosion hazard. Disconnect all power to the heater and close the External Manual Gas Valve before starting this procedure.

- 1. Turn off the filter pump and all electrical power to the heater. Close the external Manual Gas Valve.
- 2. If the heater is below the water level of the pool, close isolation valves to avoid draining the pool.
- 3. Open the Pressure Relief Valve to drain the heater.
- 4. Remove covers or doors and panels for access to the Bypass Access Plug.
- 5. Insert the Pipe Plug Tool into the Manifold Bypass Access Plug, see Figure 2.
- 6. Using a 7/8" open end wrench, or an adjustable wrench, turn the Pipe Plug Tool counter-clockwise to open the Bypass Access Plug. You will now have access to the Internal Bypass Valve.
- 7. Reassemble the Manifold Bypass Access Plug by reversing Steps 1 through 6 above.

[NOTE: A.S.M.E. manifolds must not be removed from heater units since it would void the A.S.M.E. certification.]
