

RAYPAK REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

FIELD INSTALLATION OF DRAFTHOODS FOR POOL HEATER MODELS 206, 207, 266, 267, 268, 336, 337, 406, 407, 408

These instructions are intended for use by qualified personnel specifically trained and experienced in the installation of this type of heating equipment and related system components. Installation and service personnel may be required to be licensed in some states. INSTRUCTIONS

1. Make sure that the gas and electric power have been turned off to the unit.
2. Remove the "Pagoda Top" from the jacket top and discard. See Fig. 3.

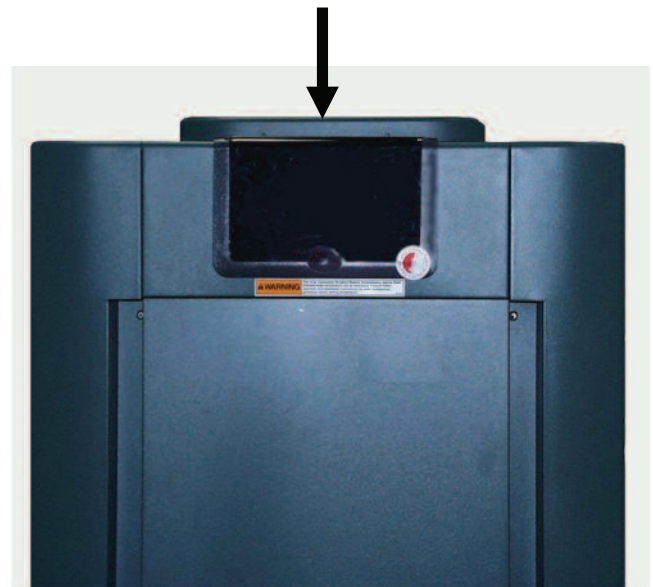

3. Remove the upper access panel. See **Fig. 4**.
4. Insert adaptor plate through the top side of the rain shield and place adaptor plate on top of the flue collector. See **Fig. 5**.
5. Make sure the panel adaptor plate does not slide off the flue collector by moving it left to right. See **Fig. 6**.
6. If installing Indoor Kit, skip to step 11. Otherwise, go to step 7.

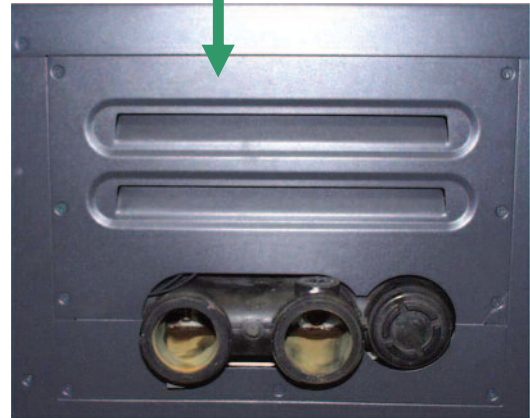

Adaptor Plate Rain Shield

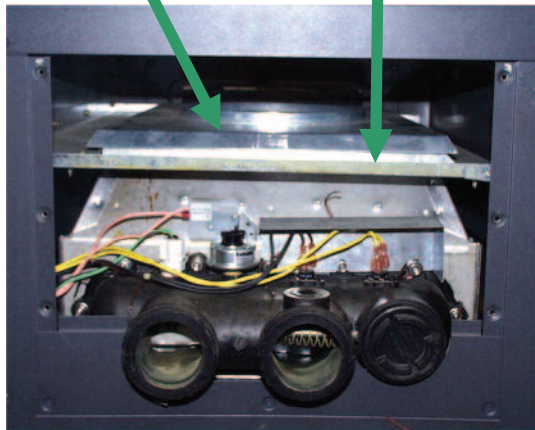

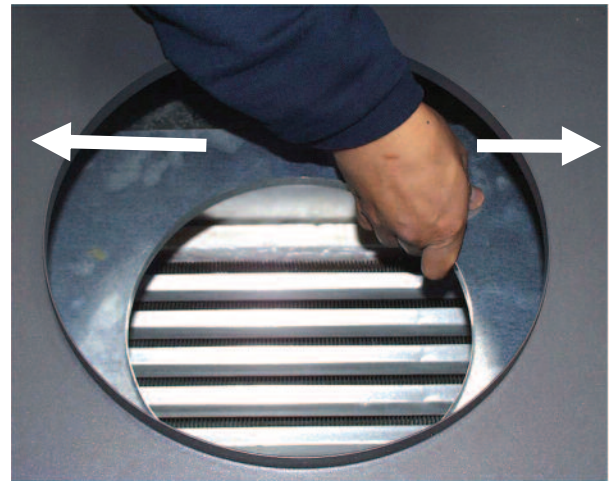

Installing the “Top Panel Cover”

OUTDOOR KIT ONLY:

7. Place the top panel cover on top of the heater.
8. Insert the rear two tabs into the slots on the heater jacket top. See **Fig. 7**.
9. Lower the top panel cover and using your thumbs, push the tabs in so the tabs fit into the slots on the top of the heater. See **Fig. 8**.
10. Lower the top panel cover flush to the top and release the tabs. They will spring into place as shown in **Fig. 9**.

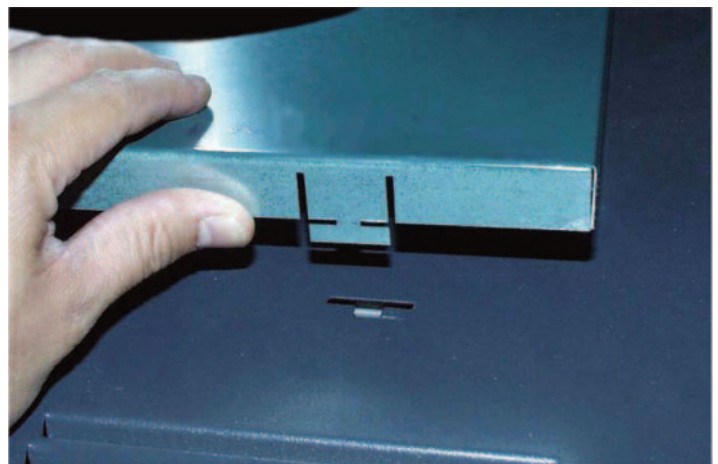

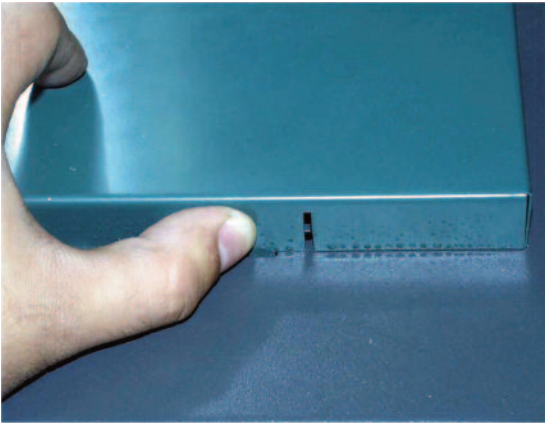

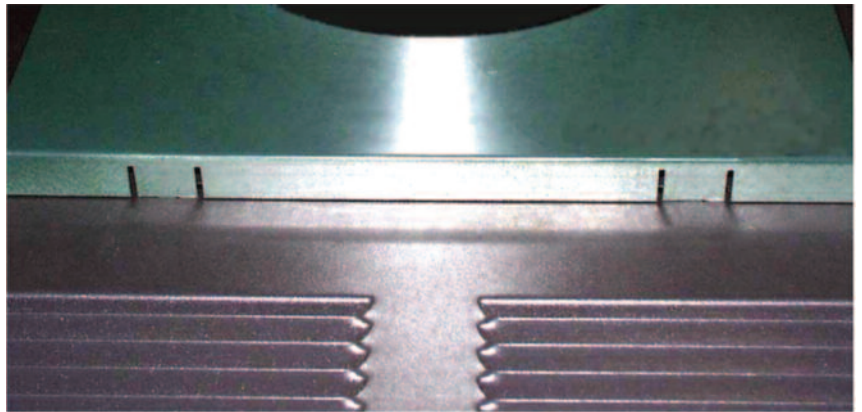

Securing the Drafthood

11. Mount the drafthood onto the adaptor plate lip inside the heater. See **Figs. 10 & 11**.

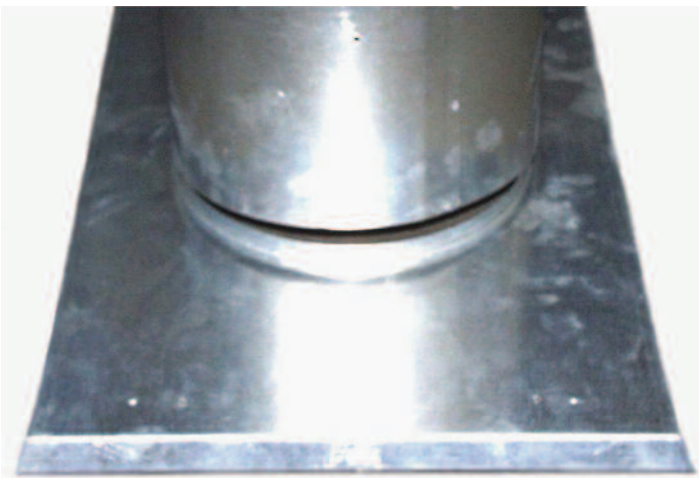

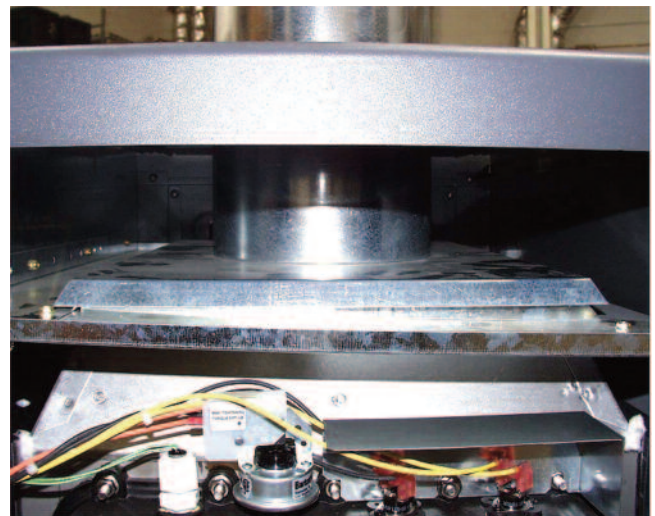

Installing the Clips

The clips are intended to engage the underside of the heater top, as shown in **Fig. 12**.

12. Insert the long edge of one clip between the top panel cover and the drafthood. Note that the gap between the parts will be much tighter on the Outdoor Kit (**Fig. 13**) than on the Indoor Kit (**Fig. 14**), because of the Top Panel Cover.

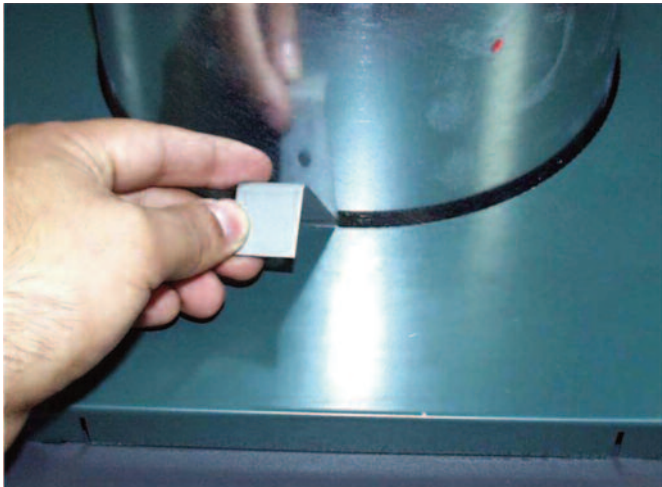


Fig. 15 (Outdoor Kit Shown)

13. With a twisting motion, rotate the clip up. See **Fig. 15**.

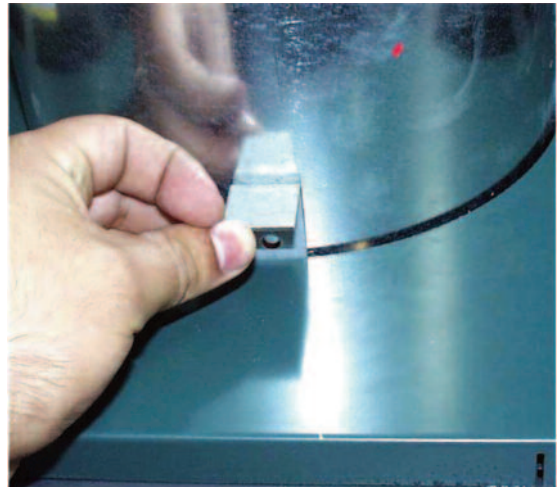


Fig. 16 (Outdoor Kit Shown)

14. Pull up on clip. See **Fig. 16**.

15. Make sure the clip engages the underside of the heater top. See **Fig. 12**.

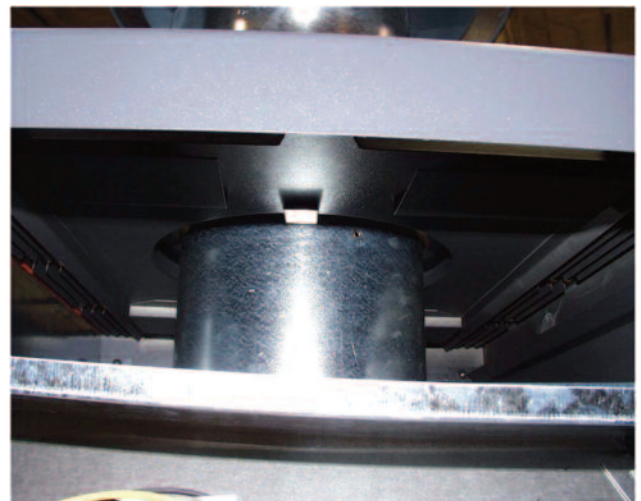

Fig. 14 - Indoor Kit

16. Hold the clip up and drill a screw through the draft hood. See **Fig. 17**.
17. Repeat steps 12-16 to install the remaining two clips, spacing them evenly around the circumference of the draft hood.

Completing the Installation

18. Once the draft hood is securely in place, re-install the upper access panel. See **Fig. 4**.
19. Turn the gas and electrical power back on. The installation is now complete.
